






Owner-Occupied Home Repair


Household Annual Income



Race / Ethnicity




Homeowner Age Breakdown






Household Annual Income


Monthly Ramp Installations 4-year comparison



Homeowner Age Breakdown






Fiscal Year Service Reach




Race/Ethnicity Breakdown






Household Income Breakdown






Fiscal year 2023-2034 WAP service area and reach


Homeowner Age Distribution (%)
